Ninety Nine \$100 tickets will be sold for each of two raffles to be held that evening. The last ticket in each raffle will earn the winner \$4,000 in cash.

The first ticket out earns \$200. Also earning \$200 will be the 25th, 50th and 75th tickets drawn.

The last ticket pulled in

each raffle will result in \$4,000 in cash being awarded to the winner.

And of all the tickets pulled and after the raffle has been won, one last ticket will be awarded \$200.

This evening is always a big one for the Crystal Lake Lions Club. All in attendance will enjoy this evening. All Crystal Lake Lions will know that the Club will earn several thousand dollars to be devoted to needy individuals and families in the Crystal Lake area.

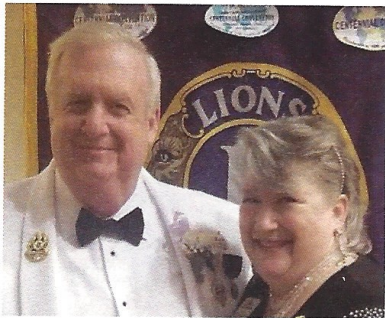
